

YOUR GUIDE TO ASSEMBLING YOUR KNOCK-DOWN




BEFORE STARTING PLEASE CHECK

- Your step is not bent or damaged in any way
- You have all the fittings required (see table)
- You have ample room to erect your step (check dimensions <u>www.klime-ezee.com/kk</u>)
- You have a spanner for an M8 bolt
- You have scissors
- If you have a KK08 or above, you will require a helper

BRACINGS & FIXTURES INFORMATION

SIZE	BRACINGS	FITTINGS
KK05 - KK06	No Bracings	No nuts or bolts required
KK07 - KK09	1 Pair of Bracings	4 x M8 nuts & M8 bolts (provided)
KK10 - KK12	2 Pairs of Bracings	6 x M8 nuts & M8 bolts (provided)
KK13 - KK15	4 Pairs of Bracings	10 x M8 nuts & M8 bolts (Provided)



STEP 1

- Move your step into a clear, open area free of obstructions.
- Carefully remove the white tie wraps from both sides of the step (see point A in diagram 1).

STEP 2

- With the step still lying flat, unfold it to allow the base side members (the lower side arms connected to the rear axle) to extend downward (see point B in diagram 1).
- Securely lock the base side members into place on the step's rear axle.
- For KK08 or below models: Once the base side members are securely attached to the rear axle, you can stand the step upright.
- For larger units: Keep the step lying flat until the end of the assembly process.

STEP 3

- Cut the remaining black cable ties to release the side cross and diagonal bracing (see diagram 2). These can now be bolted together. Do not climb the steps to perform this task!
- For larger units, keep the step lying on its back until all bolts are securely fastened.
- Once all bolts are tightened, your step is ready for use.



ADDITIONAL INFO

It is important that you inspect the step for any damage or signs of misuse before every use and complete a bi-annual maintenance inspection. You should regularly ensure that all bolts are securely tightened and that wheels and castors rotate freely.
